

## 2022 Iowa Angus Association Steer Futurity Rules, Regulations, and Qualifications

1. Will take Place at the 2021 Iowa State Fair 4-H Steer Show
2. Pay \$1000 to Champion Nominated Steer and \$500 to Res Champion Nominated Steer
3. The **First Owner** must be a paid member of the Iowa Angus Assoc. or Iowa Junior Assoc.
4. Exhibitor must be a paid member of the Iowa Junior Association prior to the start of the Iowa State Fair steer Show.
5. The steers must qualify as **born in the state of Iowa and first owner in the state of Iowa** via the American Angus Association registration paper. The **First owner's** AAA membership must include an Iowa address to qualify.
6. An Iowa Junior is able to nominated his or her own bred and owned steer.
7. Nomination need to be made by the **First Owner or Exhibitor** of steer.
8. Nomination fee is **\$50** per steer by **Feb. 1, 2022** or a **late nomination fee of \$200 per steer by July 1.**
9. All Steers need to follow American Angus Association Rules and regulations and are subject to DNA testing. The Grand and Reserve steer will be DNA tested.
10. A copy of the registration or registration number must be submitted.
11. Iowa Angus Breeders are encouraged to nominate all steers they sell in the state of Iowa
12. Entries are submitted to Iowa Angus, 1424 220<sup>th</sup> Benton, IA 50835. The entry form will be available on the Iowa Angus website ([www.iowaangus.org](http://www.iowaangus.org)).
