Addis then turned his herd over to his sons, Don & Cliff in 1966, and in 1990 when they retired, they turned their herd over to their sons, Ted & Cory. We became Greiman Family Angus and we have all been deeply involved in the Angus Association for many years. Mary and I have been active in our State Angus Association and Auxiliary Association, as well as our national organizations. We both served as officers in our respective organizations on the state level and Mary served as an officer for the American Angus Auxiliary and continues on national committees. We served as the advisors for the Iowa Junior Angus Association for 11 years and Mary is currently serving as an advisor to the National Junior Angus Board. In 2017, Mary and I served as co-chairs for our National Junior Angus Show that was hosted by all three branches of the Iowa Angus Associations. Kyle and Cole have also enjoyed great success in their Angus careers as well, serving in officer roles in the Iowa Junior Angus Association and winning three national champion heifers titles at our National Junior Angus Show.

Our current herd consists of about 30 cows, all are registered Angus. We utilize AI and IVF to produce excellent show quality heifers and a few bulls to sell privately. We are in our third year of hosting an online sale held in early October. We have an open house and the cattle are sold on the Show Circuit Online Sale format.

We are flattered and honored for the recognition, not just for our immediate family but also from my great grandfather, my Grandpa Addis, my Dad and Uncle Cliff who all laid the groundwork for our success in the Angus breed for the last 128 years. Our Angus heritage has provided us with many years of fun, friends, and the best opportunities, looking forward to many more
